Admission – 2018-20 Notice

Gandhi Centenary B.T. College, Habra is a Government Aided Institution of Teacher Education affiliated to West Bengal University of Teachers' Training, Education, Planning and Administration (WBUTTEPA). As per the instruction of the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal, WBUTTEPA and NCTE, admission in our College for the session 2018-20 is to be conducted through online procedure. Hence, applicants interested for taking admission in Gandhi Centenary B.T. College, Habra for the session 2018-20 will have to proceed according to the instruction available at the web site of the College (www.gcrtccollege.in) and submit the form and registration fee accordingly. For the Government Aided Colleges, admission process is not centralised. Hence, application for admission in the affiliating university will not lead to application for the same for this College.

Candidates must read the following admission related information before applying for admission to 2 year B. Ed. course for the session 2018-20 offered by Gandhi Centenary B.T. College, Habra and act accordingly.

Admission Related Information:

1. Online Form fill up date: From April 23, 2018 to May 12, 2018 (11.59 P.M.).

2. Online Application Fee Submission: Rs. 400.00 + Bank Charges.

[to be deposited in the form of an online generated Challan in favour of Gandhi Centenary B.T. College, Habra at any Branch of United Bank of India within May 14, 2018]

3. Total Intake Capacity: 50 (25 for deputed candidates, and 25 for Fresher candidates) Deputed candidates in different subjects will be selected on the basis of experience. Fresher candidates in different subjects will be selected strictly on merit basis.

5. Eligibility criteria:

Marks required - Applicants, both deputed and fresher, must have at least 50% marks in Bachelors' Degree and / or in the Masters' Degree Examination in any recognized University. There shall be a relaxation of 5% Marks for SC / ST candidates.

Age limit - 37 years for fresher candidates as on 01.07.2018. There shall be a relaxation of age 5 years for SC/ST candidates.

Subject to opt - Candidates must opt one school subject that they have studied either at Graduation or at Post Graduation level, from the following subjects

A. Language Group: i) Bengali. ii) English.

B. Social Science Group: i) History. ii) Geography. iii) Education.

C. Mathematics.

D. Science Group: i) Physical Science (Physics, Chemistry and Electronics)

ii) Biological Science (Botany, Zoology, Physiology, Molecular Biology and Microbiology)

7. Fees for the B. Ed. Course: For Fresher Candidates - Rs. 45,000/- per year (For Semester - I / III Rs. 25,000/- while for Semester - II / IV Rs. 20,000/-).

For Deputed Candidates - Rs. 47,400/- per year (For Semester - I / III Rs. 27,400/- while for Semester - II / IV Rs. 20,000/-).

At the Time of Admission: Rs. 25,000/- for Fresher Candidates and Rs. 27,400/- for Deputed Candidates (Course Fee For Semester - I)

9. Documents to be produced for verification by all candidates:

- ii) All credentials and testimonials, in original.
- iii) SC/ST/PH certificate (if any) in original.
- iv) Four copies of recent passport size photographs.

Additionally, Deputed Candidates must also bring —

- i) Managing Committee resolution regarding release from the school for the session 2018-20 and
- ii) DI Approval.

*** N.B.- On the scheduled dates candidates must come prepared with the required admission fees in hand [to be deposited in the name of Gandhi Centenary B.T. College, Habra, at United Bank of India, Sree Chaitanya College Branch only]. However, admission will be done strictly on merit basis according to the distribution of seats (as stated in the tables above). Once the seats are filled admission will be closed.

Fees once submitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.
